

to sort and tidy all of them on the screen. Now, with the auto-arrange mode, the software automatically organizes the images on the screen and displays them neatly. It is truly amazing."



The dashboard image gallery is also an important feature to Dr. Benito. It provides an axial view and 3D preview of 3D volumes, which allows him to easily identify volume—preventing the need to open each file individually to find the right one.

Another efficiency-boosting capability is the new image processing feature. "I can change a setting or use a filter and apply it to multiple images at once," said Dr. Benito. "It saves a lot of time."

Treatment plans are easier for patients to understand

Dr. Benito can rapidly assemble a comprehensive patient file, which greatly facilitates case presentation. "When I go over my diagnosis with new patients, I use two screens," said Dr. Benito. "On one screen, I manage the software. On the other, I display all the images together and explain them. My patients are really surprised to see so many images. They really appreciate the effort. And, because of the images, they understand their diagnoses more easily and feel more involved with the treatment."
